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This document lists every legal, government, and scholarly source cited in *Our Home and Native Land: An Indigenous Federalist Case Against Separation*, together with a link to a free, publicly accessible copy of the source where one exists. Where no free online full text could be verified, that is stated plainly rather than guessed at. All links were checked at the time of writing; court and government sites occasionally restructure their URLs, so a citation is given in every case so the source can be relocated if a link goes stale.
